Initiatives such as **The Future-Powered Project**, which brings 100% clean solar energy to off-grid schools, is one part of a broader environmental commitment. We are also restoring fragile marine ecosystems through our **coral rehabilitation** programmes and advancing **circular waste management** and terrestrial conservation efforts. Taken together, these initiatives demonstrate how environmental action can directly strengthen communities and build lasting social resilience.

Through **Projek Legasi Johor** and programmes such as the **Basic Weaving Intensive Course for Kain Benang Johor**, we safeguard Johor's cultural identity whilst elevating local craft and supporting the livelihoods of our artisans.



COMMUNITY WELL-BEING

We are bridging healthcare gaps through **early detection and occupational therapy screenings**, ensuring communities receive support where it matters most. Our commitment to mental health is equally vital; through the Mental Health & Special Needs Awareness Programme, we provided critical early intervention screenings for 203 children in 2025 to address neurodevelopmental and mental health challenges. We are equally committed to creating inclusive career opportunities for the differently-abled, recognising that a truly resilient society leaves no one behind.

Together, these efforts ensure that Johor's economic vitality is matched by social resilience.
